- Sponge

- Potholder

- Aluminum Foil
- Paper Towels
- Toilet Paper
- Table cloth w/holders
- Cook set with:
 - Serving Spoons
 - Spatula
 - Cooking fork
 - Large knife
 - Paring knife
- Matches
- Can opener
- Bleach (disinfectant)
- Pam
- Vegetable oil
- Spices
- Salt and Pepper
- Hand sanitizer
- Dish towels (2)

The following additional items are needed for patrol cooking, but will not normally fit in the chuckbox:

- Legs for the chuckbox
- Stove
- Stove Stand
- Propane (make sure there's enough)
- Wash tubs (3)
- Water Containers
- Pot with lid, large
- Pot with lid, medium
- Pot with lid, small
- Frying pan
- Coffee pot
- Pitcher

- Shovel
